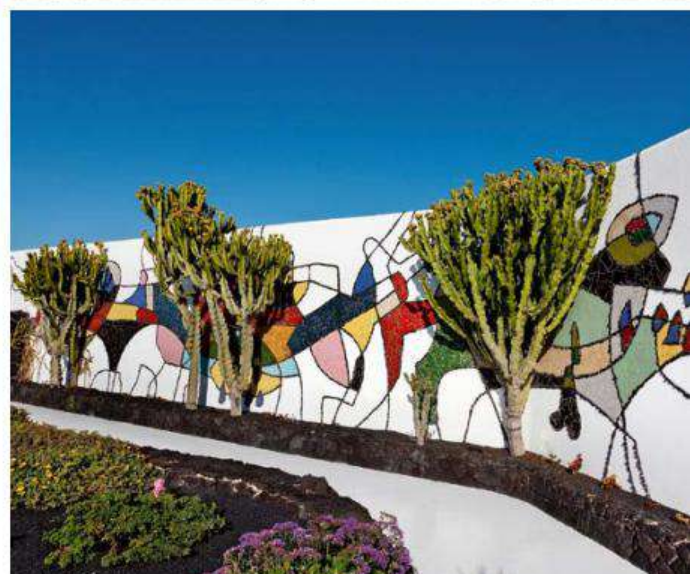


## Landscapes of lava and sand: Fuerteventura & Lanzarote

## Sun-spoiled Fuerteventura

Fuerteventura is the oldest of the Canary Islands. It began to rise up out of the Atlantic Ocean about 22 million years ago. Known among connoisseurs as "the beach", Fuerteventura is a mecca for sun worshippers. A beachscape of 150 kilometers/93 miles surrounds the island. And water sports enthusiasts also get their money's worth: They find ideal wind and water conditions for wind and kite surfing.

### Diverse Tenerife

The largest island of the Canaries leaves nothing to be desired: With the third-highest volcano on earth, meter-high lava tongues and bizarre rock formations, the Teide National Park is part of the World Natural Heritage and a must for hiking enthusiasts. 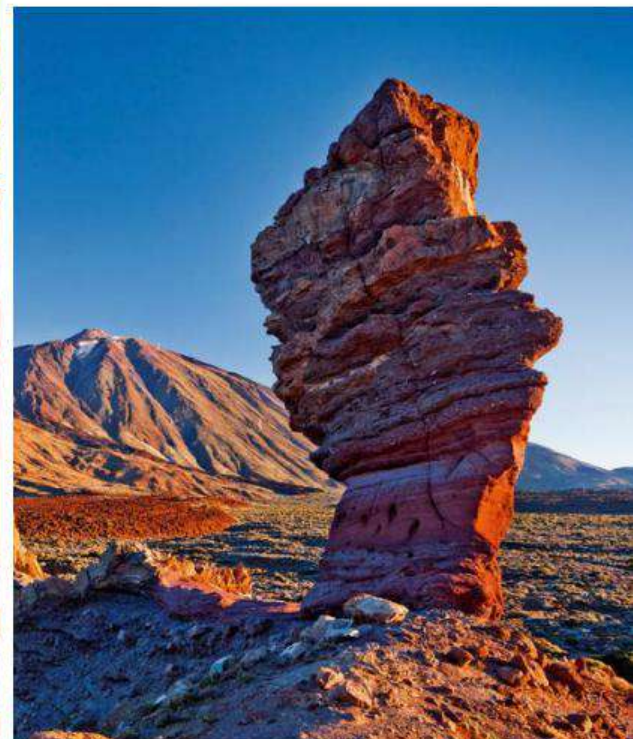

## Gran Canaria – the miniature continent

With its picturesque old town and one of the best city beaches in Europe, the island's capital Las Palmas is a lively place to visit. In contrast, the south entices with a beautiful natural area of unique sand dune formations. For more than 150 years, the island has been offering new strength and vitality to those seeking relaxation. The center around the extinct volcano Pico de las Nieves surprises with a completely different atmosphere. Rising clouds, wafting mist, lush valleys, deep canyons and mountain villages still remind of its origins.







## The natural beauties: La Gomera, El Hierro & La Palma

### Mystical La Gomera

The 40 sq. km/15 sq. miles of Garajonay National Park, a UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site, make for a rare spot on earth: With its rippling river courses, waterfalls and dense moss, the national park in the heart of La Gomera seems a relic of prehistoric times. Laurel trees and ferns form an evergreen cloud forest.

### The beauty La Palma

La Palma is not only called "The Beautiful Island" for its majestic volcanic landscapes and lush forests with prehistoric vegetation, but also for its impressive starry skies. Thanks to hardly any light pollution, you will find unique conditions for stargazing in the UNESCO certified "Starlight Reserve".

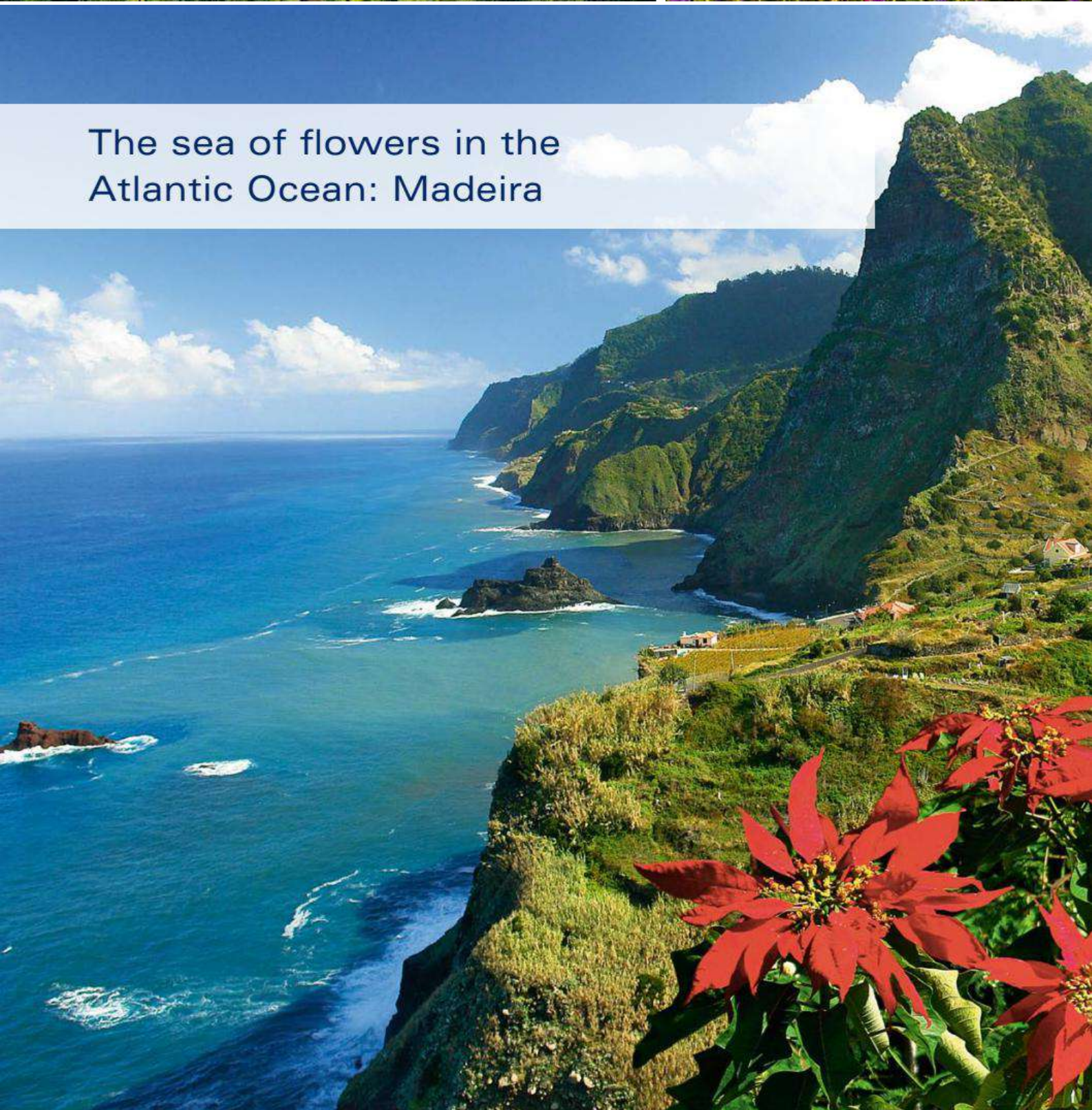
## Pristine El Hierro

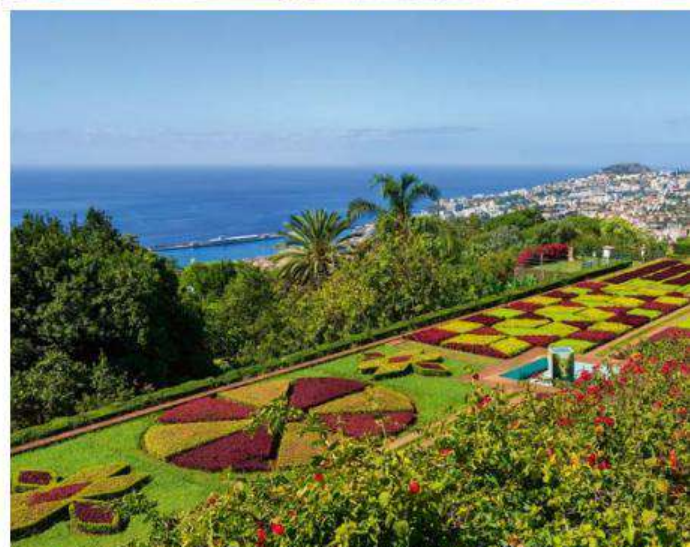


## The sea of flowers in the Atlantic Ocean: Madeira

Since then, one or two of the island's export hits have achieved worldwide fame: Madeira Wine, for example, which inspired both the founding fathers of the USA and Shakespeare. Or Cristiano Ronaldo, who headed out from Funchal to become a world-famous soccer player. One tradition has remained true to the island to this day: Above the island's capital, picturesque Monte towers in the hills. The former home of the nobility and the rich still sends its famous basket sleds down the steep Caminho to Funchal.

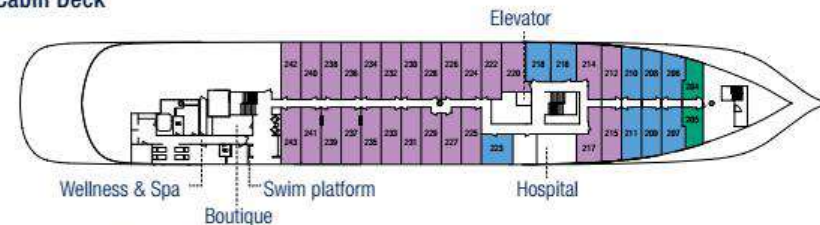

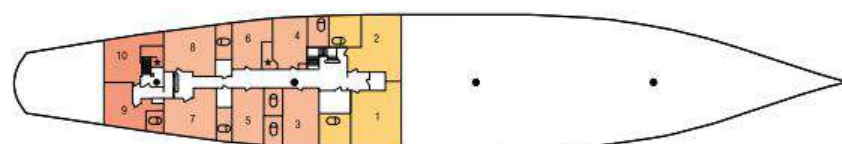

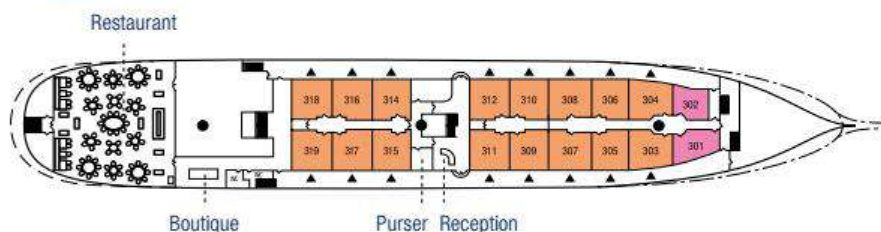


## Deck Plan of SEA CLOUD II

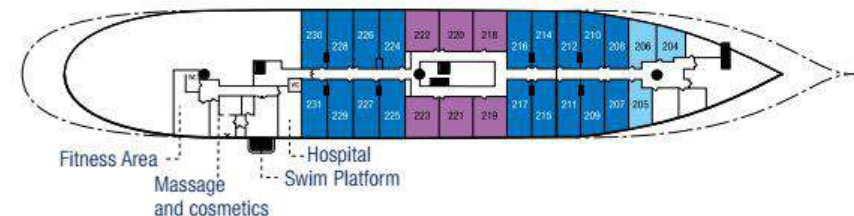
